## 2024-2025 Financial Aid application Procedure

- At the time of registration if applying for Financial Aid, have your most recent Tax Return available as well as your 4 consecutive weeks of your most recent pay stubs of both parents (whoever is employed).

We have a limited budget and applications with all documents submitted will be looked into first.

## Can I get financial assistance?

Sure. When filling out the registration application form you must upload the following documents: Your most recent Tax Return available as well as your 4 consecutive weeks of your most recent pay stubs of both parents (whoever is employed). More documents may be asked if necessary.

#### When will I know if FA is approved?

You will receive communication from <a href="school@al-hidaya.org">school@al-hidaya.org</a> with an invoice showing the discount. Keep in mind that you do not get Financial Aid on the fee of the Application, (if returning) re-enrolment, or the material fee which will need to be paid ahead of time.

## How much assistance can I expect?

There are many factors that need to be looked at before it can be determined. It all depends on the school budget and the individual's situation. However, please note that we can ONLY go up to 50% maximum.

## Will applying for financial aid hurt my child getting accepted?

It will not. We believe every child deserves an opportunity to be part of our school.
